1 Lattner Studio • Suzi Lattner Zwissler

Visit the working studio of artist Suzi Lattner Zwissler tucked amid tranquil pines and gardens. Inspired by land, sky and water this is where her vision transpires. Her vibrant paintings are each unique unto themselves. Ranging in subject, style and mood her focus is color and light. Suzi paints both on site and/or in her studio exploring the media at hand with discovery and intent.

2 Blue Star Pottery Mark Williams

For over 30 years the studio of Mark Williams has featured his handmade stoneware pottery. Mark's classic and elegant textured designs embellish his functional pitchers, canisters and bowls. He creates his forms by combining the pottery techniques of textured slab and throwing on the potter's wheel. Come and see Mark's newly built gas fired Salt Kiln.

The circa 1892 Casco Town Hall is the home and studio of silversmith Christine Bruno. Nationally collected, her design aesthetic is simple and modern with great respect paid to nature.
